Dear Parents/Guardians:

RE: Individuals qualifying as Critical Services Workers (CSW's) – update

Just a kind reminder to all Holy Cross School parents/ guardians that Manitoba Education and the Government of MB in their respective documents entitled “#RESTARTMB RESTORING SAFE SCHOOL - Guidance for Critical (Red) Response Level for MB Schools” and “State of Emergency and Public Health Orders” as of May 8, 2021 considers the following to be critical services workers:

- Health/Health Services Workers
- Kindergarten to Grade 12 Education Providers (all teachers, administrators, and support staff)
- Child Care Workers
- Law Enforcement
- Correctional Workers
- Fire and Paramedic First Responders
- Direct Social Services and Child Protection Workers
- Members of the Armed Forces
- Elected Official and their staff

Additional critical services workers may include people who provide critical services to Manitobans, such as front-line natural resource workers, essential supply chain staff (e.g., truck drivers delivering food, medications and other essential goods); food industry staff working in food processing plants, gas station attendants, and grocery store staff.

If any of the above categories apply to you then you are considered a critical services worker and your child in Grade PK - 6 is eligible to attend school in person from May 13th – May 28th for temporary remote learning at Holy Cross School. If you are not considered a critical services worker as per the description above, or your child is in Grade 7 or 8, your child must remain at home for the period of May 13th – May 28th at Holy Cross School.

Thank you again for your cooperation and understanding in these rapidly changing times and once more I can assure you that our staff are here to assist you.
