To all our faithful Tab Collectors,

Thank you once again for all that you do for Tabs for Wheelchairs! We hope everyone is taking care during this very difficult time!

All the tabs that were collected over this last year were finally delivered to Western Scrap Metals in October. A total of just a little over **10,000 pounds (approximately 15 million tabs)** were brought in. We have just received a cheque for **\$5,638**. We did better than I had expected because two months ago, the price for aluminum per pound was only 28 cents. Presently, it is going for 40 cents per pound, but Western Scrap Metals did even better and gave us 50 cents per pound. **Thank you Western Scrap!**

We would also like to take this opportunity to thank all those who dropped off metal items (small or large) directly to Western Scrap! This has definitely added to our total. Anyone who wishes to drop off anything recyclable, please always remember to let them know that you want this amount to be added to the Tabs for Wheelchairs account.

This is the same for **Wesman Salvage** in **Brandon**. In August, from everything they received this last year, a cheque was sent to us for **\$1,768.40. Truly amazing!** Thank you! Thank you! Thank you!

A huge thanks also needs to go out to all those who gave monetary donations! We definitely wouldn't do as well without your generous contributions! Don't forget that tax receipts are given for donations over \$20.
