PICK UP AND DROP OFF REIMNDERS

Please remember parents that during AM and PM Drop-off on Dubuc Street we CANNOT double park on the front street. That area is reserved for our kindergarten and pre-k parents to drop their children off safely. There is ample parking and drop-off space behind the school for all 1-8 students.

For AM and PM pickup/drop-off in the back a reminder that when entering the parking lot off of Genthon Stree to please turn RIGHT when accessing the parking lot and travel around the parking to drop-off and then leave through the same entrance. Continuing straight causes delays and traffic jams.

Additionally on the Bramar side back alley please do not stop on both sides of the lane as it makes it difficult for other cars to pass. Please stay to the left hand side of the backlane on the Bramar side. Thank you.

CONGRATS DR. BAJAJ!

Dr. Anju Bajaj Honoured with King Charles III Coronation Medal and BioScience Educator of the Year Award

Dr. Anju Bajaj, a STEM educator at Holy Cross School and STEM Advisor Manitoba Catholic Schools in Winnipeg, has recently been honoured with two prestigious awards: the King Charles III Coronation Medal and the BioScience Educator of the Year Award.

The King Charles III Coronation Medal was presented to Dr. Bajaj by The Honourable Terry Duguid, Minister of Sport and Minister responsible for Prairies Economic Development Canada. This medal recognises individuals who have made outstanding contributions to their communities across Canada, emphasising service, environmental stewardship, sustainability, and the nation's rich diversity. Upon receiving the medal, Dr. Bajaj expressed her gratitude, stating, "This recognition is not just a personal achievement—it is a testament to the incredible people, mentors, and communities who have shaped my journey."

In addition to this honour, Dr. Bajaj was named the BioScience Educator of the Year by the BioScience Association Manitoba (BAM). This award celebrates educators who have inspired and empowered youth to explore the world of bioscience. Reflecting on this achievement, Dr. Bajaj remarked, "Standing on that stage, I couldn't help but reflect on the journey that brought me here. The first time I received this honour from BAM in 2018 as Outstanding Science Educator of the Year, it was more than just an award—it was a turning point."

Dr. Bajaj's dedication to STEM education is evident through her various roles, including serving as a Let's Talk Science Teacher Leader, Chair of the Board of Directors for the Mood Disorders Association of Manitoba, SCWIST volunteer, consultant, researcher, and dynamic public speaker. She is also the founder and coordinator of the nationally accredited Bison Regional Science Fair, providing a platform for students to showcase their scientific talents.

Beyond her contributions to STEM, Dr. Bajaj is committed to holistic student development, creating hands-on learning experiences that foster academic excellence as well as social, emotional, and physical growth. Her leadership extends to organising clubs and programs that connect STEM with real-world applications, igniting a deep appreciation for science among students.

These recent accolades add to Dr. Bajaj's impressive list of honours, including the Prime Minister's Award for Teaching Excellence in STEM. Her relentless pursuit of excellence and passion for empowering the next generation underscore her invaluable contributions to education and community service.
